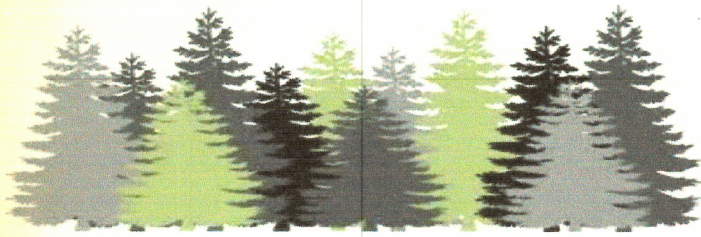

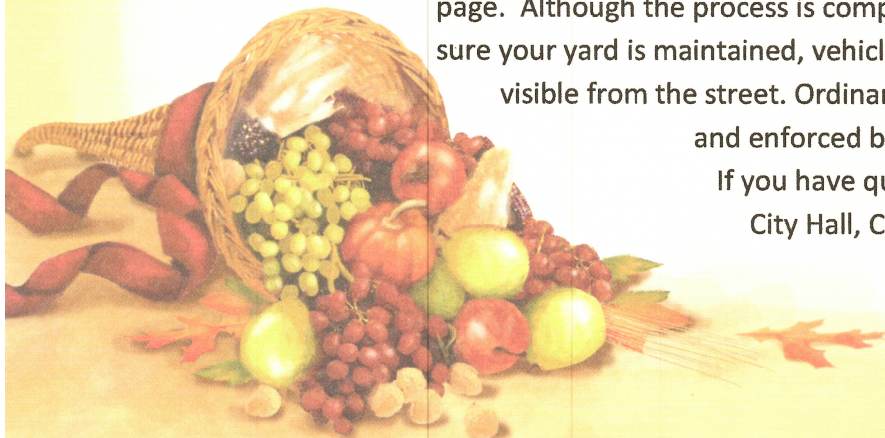

To All Westfir Residents,

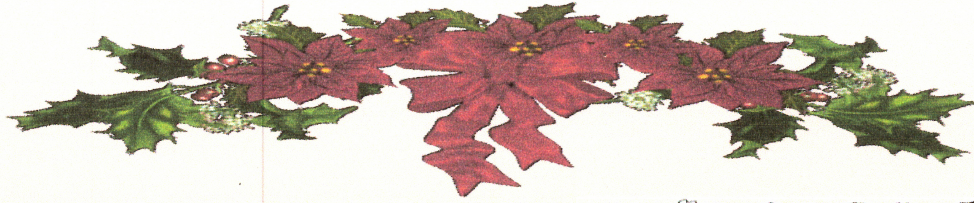

Please keep in mind that within City limits there are Ordinances in place to help keep Westfir safe, attractive, and welcoming. The most common complaints that are filed at City Hall are violations of Ordinance 138, which addresses nuisances (weeds, discarded items, junk vehicles, etc.) The Ordinance in its entirety can be found on our website and at City Hall. Copies are available for \$0.10 per page. Although the process is complaint driven, it's always a good idea to make sure your yard is maintained, vehicles are legal, and discarded items are not visible from the street. Ordinances are drafted and enacted by City Council and enforced by both City employees and the Police Dept. If you have questions or need clarification, please contact City Hall, City Council, or attend a City Council meeting.

Cookie donations are needed for Saturday, December 1st.

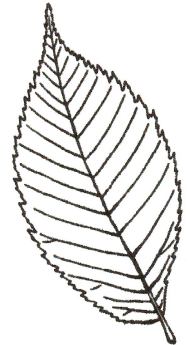
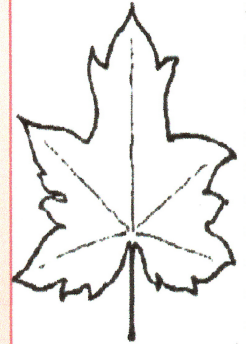
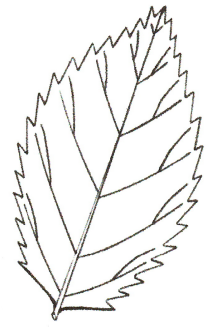

Additional help will be needed on the day of the event.

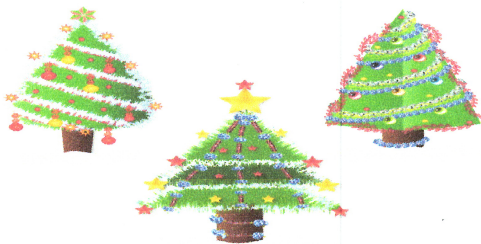
