

## PUBLIC NOTICE:

### WESTFIR CITY ORDINANCE NO. 138 PERTAINING TO NOXIOUS GROWTHS, GRASS AND WEEDS

By City ordinance, no person in charge of real property shall allow noxious growths on the property. Noxious growths are hereby declared a nuisance. It shall be the duty of any owner or person in charge of real property to abate noxious growths from said property. The owner and person in charge shall be jointly and severally liable for the cost of abatement as provided in this ordinance. **Noxious growths are defined as:**

**a)** grass and weeds more than 12 inches high, **b)** poison oak and poison ivy, **c)** blackberry bushes that extend into a public thoroughfare or cross a property line, **d)** vegetation that is **1.** a health hazard, **2.** a fire hazard, **3.** a traffic hazard because it impairs the view of the public thoroughfare or otherwise makes the use of the thoroughfare hazardous, **e)** noxious growths does not include vegetation that constitutes an agricultural crop unless that vegetation is a health hazard, a fire hazard, or a traffic hazard.

The City of Westfir intends to abate noxious growths at the expense of the property owner, 10 days after the last publication of this notice in the local newspaper of record.
