A public meeting of the City of Westfir City Council will be held on June 5, 2023, at 5:30 pm in person at City Hall at 47441 Westoak Road and via audio/video teleconference. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, as approved by the Budget Committee.
