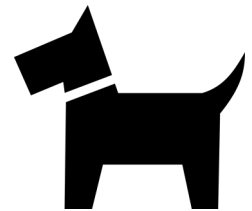
Dog Licenses Are Due This Month

If City Hall has a record of a dog in your household, you will find an application for 2024 included with your water bill this month. **Please fill out the application and return to City Hall (with the appropriate fee) and rabies vaccine certificate by January 31, 2024**

Applications require that a current rabies certificate be submitted at the time of licensing. **If your dog needs a new rabies certificate you can take advantage of our low-cost rabies clinic, planned for Saturday, April 6.** If you sign up for the clinic, we will defer that requirement until the clinic date.

If you have a dog and do not receive the application with your water bill, please stop by City Hall or download an application from the City website.

Notice: A \$15 late fee will be assessed to owners who have not renewed a license within 30 days of its expiration. (Per Resolution 521.)

The Budget Committee is composed of five City officials and five appointed citizen members.

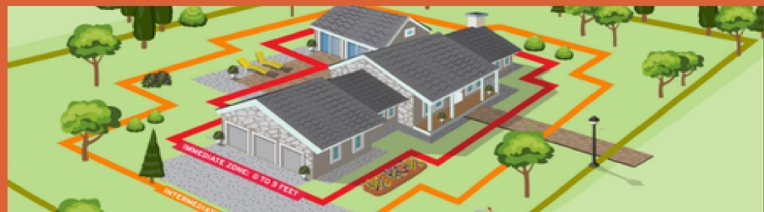
To be eligible for appointment, the applicant must:
