September 16–20 is SepticSmart Week

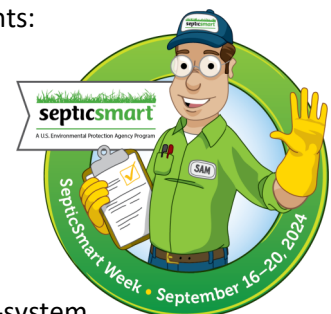
SepticSmart Week is EPA's annual event highlighting how to care for your septic system. Around half of the homes in the City of Westfir have septic systems. If your septic system is not properly maintained you may be risking your family's health, hurting the environment, and flushing thousands of dollars down the drain.

Septic system maintenance is not complicated, and it does not need to be expensive. Upkeep comes down to four key elements:

- Inspect and Pump Frequently
- Use Water Efficiently
- Properly Dispose of Waste
- Maintain Your Drainfield
