Upcoming City Council Vacancy

Councilor Kelly Packard will be stepping down on December 31, 2024. The City of Westfir is recruiting to fill his seat. The term will start January 6, 2025, and will be up for election in November 2026.

To be eligible, the applicant must:

1. Have resided in the City for six months prior to appointment;
2. Be registered to vote in the City; and
3. Not be an officer, agent or employee of the City.

It's Time to License Dogs!

Every dog that resides within the Westfir City limits is required to have a license (Westfir City Ordinance #120). Licenses are valid January 1 to December 31 each year.

Residents on our list of dog owners will receive an application for 2025 with their December water bill.

Please fill out the application and return it to City Hall (with the appropriate fee) by January 31, 2025.

License fees:

- Intact animals: \$16 regular or \$8 for seniors
- Neutered/spayed animals: \$8 regular or \$4 for seniors
- **A \$15 late fee will be assessed to owners who have not renewed a license within 30 days of its expiration.**
(Per Resolution 521.)

All dogs are required to have a **current rabies vaccination certificate** on file with the City in order to be licensed.

The annual low-cost rabies vaccination clinic will most likely be held in April.

If you have a dog and don't receive an application with your water bill, please stop by City Hall and pick one up, or give us a call and we will post or e-mail one to you.

It is required that all dogs in our City have a license, are vaccinated, and have an ID tag.

If you need a City ID tag for your pet's collar, we have them available. Just let us know!
