PUBLIC NOTICE: WESTFIR CITY ORDINANCE NO. 138 PERTAINING TO NOXIOUS GROWTH, GRASS AND WEEDS

By City ordinance, no person in charge of real property shall allow noxious growth on the property. Noxious growth is hereby declared a nuisance. It shall be the duty of any owner or person in charge of real property to abate noxious growth from said property. The owner and person in charge shall be jointly and severally liable for the cost of abatement as provided in this ordinance. **Noxious growth is defined as:**

a) grass and weeds more than 12 inches high; **b)** poison oak and poison ivy; **c)** blackberry bushes that extend into a public thoroughfare or cross a property line; and **d)** vegetation that is a health hazard, a fire hazard, or a traffic hazard because it impairs the view of the public thoroughfare or otherwise makes the use of the thoroughfare hazardous. Noxious growth does not include vegetation that constitutes an agricultural crop unless that vegetation is a health hazard, a fire hazard, or a traffic hazard.

The City of Westfir intends to abate noxious growth at the expense of the property owner, 10 or more days after the last publication of this notice in a local newspaper of record.

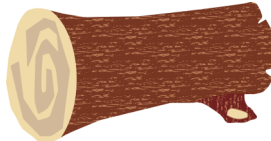
Brock's Wood Lot Under New Ownership

As of April 1, Brock's Wood Lot came under the ownership of Brink's Land Improvement. The wood debris recycling program will continue at 76272 Industrial Park Way in Oakridge.

There is no fee and no permit required to dump clean, woody yard debris. As usual, items NOT accepted include grass clippings, leaves, blackberries, weeds and root balls. The program is for households only, not for businesses.
